

**CITY OF GILBERT
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING
TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2013
COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

Mayor Skenzich called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Skenzich, Councilors Kutsi, Nemanick, Schutte and Skalko.

Absent: None

Staff Present: Interim-City Clerk Mackley and Administrative Secretary Devich.

Mayor Skenzich stated the Public Hearing was required in accordance to State statute 340A.408 Subd. 3a., to allow the owners of liquor establishments to comment on the increases in liquor license fees.

Todd Devich owner of Devo's Sand Bar stated he and most of the other bar owners in Gilbert had come to a previous work session meeting when the council was discussing the fee schedule and increasing liquor licenses fees and Mike Sailer owner of the Wandering Pines had spoke at that time for the bar owners in town. The Council stated there have not been any changes to the increased liquor license fees since the work session meeting and reiterated the lack of raising the fees in 20 years has made it necessary that they be reviewed and brought in line with other communities in the area.

The Council requested Mr. Devich to submit a list of his questions and concerns to the City Clerk Office so they could be addressed.
