

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE GILBERT
CITY COUNCIL
TUESDAY, JANUARY 29TH, 2013

Mayor Pro Tem Tom Nemanick called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m. Councilors Skalko, Kutsi and Schutte were in attendance as was Clerk Harper. Mayor Skenzich was absent but requested, by telephone, to be on the interview committee, should one be appointed.

The Gilbert City Council met to discuss the hiring process for the open City Mechanic's position. Through discussion, Council reduced the nine (9) applicants to a final four (4). Clerk Harper was directed to set up the interviews, each lasting one half (1/2) hour for Monday, February 4th and Tuesday, February 5th at 6 and 6:30 p.m. Councilors stated that they all wanted to be there for the interviews, so no committee was appointed.

Upon completion of the interviews on Tuesday, February 5th, Council will determine which applicant they will hire.

Motion by Councilor Schutte, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Nemanick, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Nemanick adjourned the meeting at 5:42 p.m.
